  - Margins should be 1 inch or 2.54 cm in on all sides
  - Use Arial font, 10 pt for body, and 9 pt font for tables and figures.
  - Replace this instructional text with the text of your abstract.
  - Do not change formatting.
  - Presentations should be either original research which has been substantially completed or a review of literature which has not yet been published as a full paper in a scientific journal.
  - Abstracts must be written in English and must be free of grammatical errors. Ensuring linguistic accuracy is the sole responsibility of the author. **Abstracts that are not well written and which also do not conform with the guidelines will be rejected.**
  - The abstract should be concise and made up of introduction, materials and methods, results and discussion, conclusion, acknowledgement, relevant references or an appropriate format for review of literature.
- NOTE: A literature review should have basic elements including an introduction or background information section; the body of the review containing the discussion of sources; and, finally, a conclusion and/or recommendations section to end the paper.
- If you choose to include tables, graphs, or figures, they must fit within the margins (1 inch or 2.54 cm) and within page limits.
  - Include a table and/or figure title, units, indications of the statistical approach and significance.
